UPCOMING STUDENT & PARENT SURVEYS

CITY OF SANDPOINT: HIGH FIVE SURVEY

Discussion: The city of Sandpoint has been given a grant by the Blue Cross Foundation of Idaho to focus on improving the health of our youth. FBCS has been asked to participate in a student and parent survey that will take place this month. The results of the survey will help the city identify the greatest areas of need in our community and help them better create an action plan. The student surveys will take place during the school day. Parents who take part in the survey will be entered into a drawing for two lift tickets at Schweitzer Mountain Resort.

This survey will take place before October 17th and will reference the City of Sandpoint in the information packet.

FBCS ACCREDITATION SURVEY

PARENT CANVAS ACCOUNTS AND FEDERAL FERPA REQUIREMENTS.

In order to stay compliant with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, we must keep student records and grades secure in all correspondence. This means that FBCS staff is not allowed to email student progress with our unsecured email.
