The Main Pathway

Be in compliance with FBCS Attendance Policy

To promoted to High school, 8th grade students are to also complete a Career Exploration Class.

Pathways to Promotion to the next grade

- Develop a habit of working hard and using time wisely.
- Continually think and ask questions that will help you understand assignments.
- Communicate with parents and teachers about academic progress and anything with which you are struggling.
- Attend Friday tutoring times with teachers when you need help.
- Revise work to meet mastery of skills.
- Attend class prepared to learn and with energized minds.
- Maintain a cooperative and solution-based mindset.
- Be in regular attendance during the school year and be on time to school each day. (Refer to the Attendance Policy for more information).
- Students in danger of not meeting the promotion requirements will meet with the Academic Intervention team to discuss required steps to reach academic success. Family and students are expected to be active participants in these meetings.

The Alternate Pathway

Must meet at least two of the three following requirements

Must show significant growth from spring to spring ISAT tests or grade level proficiency on spring ISAT test

Must pass all core and elective Semester 2 classes

Must complete IDLA summer school with a grade of "C" (parent responsible for tuition)
